The Parade will commence promptly at 10:30am, traveling on 6th Avenue to the festival site. Leading the parade of bikes will be the renowned <u>CYO Emerald Knights Marching Band</u>.

Bicycle Helmet Giveaway 9:00 am

The Kenosha Police Department will be on hand to give away free bicycle helmets to the first 100 children at the Bloomin' Bike Parade (Library Park location). Helmets are courtesy of Habush Habush & Rottier, S.C. and will be fitted and provided free while supplies last.

MAIN FESTIVAL SITE

The "hub" of Bloomin' Days will be Downtown at 6th Avenue between 54th & 55th Streets. All activities will take place between 11am and 7pm, unless otherwise noted.

The service assigns a specific number to an owner's bike, which is then entered into the KPD database with the owner's contact information. The database can then help in the recovery efforts if your bicycle is ever lost or stolen.

- **Bicycle Demonstrations** Bike maintenance, bus loading, and other helpful demonstrations to get around Kenosha on your bike!

- Children's Games & Activities Face painting, hula-hooping, jump roping, bubbles, juggling and more!
